

SAMPLE OF A SIMPLE WILL

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF JOHN R. DOE

I, John R. Doe of, Anytown in the Province of Ontario, declare this to be my Last Will and Testament and direct the following disposition be made of my estate.

1. I direct that all expenses of my last illness and funeral be paid as soon after my death as conveniently may be done.
2. I give, bequeath and devise all of my estate, real and personal, in which I have any interest at the time of my death not otherwise effectively disposed of, to my wife, BARBARA DOE, if she survives me by thirty (30) days.
3. In the event my wife, BARBARA DOE, does not survive me by thirty (30) days, I then direct that my estate be divided equally amongst our three children, CHAD DOE, RYAN DOE, AND JENNIFER DOE and any other child that may be born or adopted by my wife, BARBARA DOE, and me. If any of our children do not survive me, his or her share of my estate shall then pass to his or her issue by right of representation.
4. I appoint my wife, BARBARA DOE, executor of my estate and I direct that no bond be required of her as my executor, and said executor or any person or corporation appointed in her place and stead, shall have full power, authority and discretion to do any and all things necessary for the complete administration of my estate, including the power of sell at public or private sale, and without order of any Court, any and all real or personal property belonging to my estate, and to settle and adjust any and all claims, debts and demands against or in favour of my estate, as fully as I could do if living.
